Department of Information Science & Engineering conducted a one-day Department Club event "Brain Chase" on 11-05-2018 in Seminar Hall 4. The Students of ISE, (MVJCE) participated in the event.

First Round: Tech Quiz

It was a technical Quiz consisting of MCQ's that include topics such as General Aptitude, Logical Reasoning, Programming Snippets, etc. Twenty MCQ's in the above listed topics were solved in 20 minutes. This round is open for all individuals provided they form a group of 2.

Second round: Blind Coding

Blind Coding: The teams, who qualify the first round, will be eligible for this coding round. The teams will be given a set of 5 programs out of which they can choose to solve any three within the given time frame. The rules are as follows,

- The teams initially need to write the code while the monitor is switched OFF.
- Once the team is confident about their code, they can run it on any compiler. Each team gets two chances to rectify their code and provide the desired output.
- If they fail to provide the result within the number of chances, points will be awarded on basis of criteria such as number of errors.

Third Round: Mystery Room

The teams, who qualify the second round, take part in this round. The teams will have to design a virtual mystery room using any programming language, where they need to hide the 6

inventories as directed. The designs of the teams will be swapped based on the leader board. The teams need to modify the opponent's code to find out the hidden inventories.

Finally, the developed Code created by teams was judged by ISE faculties and the best two teams were selected. The winners were students from ISE department Shreya Singal, Sanjana Rane (8th semester) and runners were Prashanth, Prasanna (2nd semester). The winners, runners & participants were felicitated with cash prize and certificates
