




The event took place in the double lobby of the college, which was located opposite room number 033.

As the clock ticked away, some participants showed signs of excitement, while others seemed to be deep in thought, trying to crack the more challenging clues.




It was a sight to behold as these young minds engaged in an intellectual battle of words and wits.
