



REPORT ON NADAVATHI – HEALTH SURVEY

NSS unit of MVJ College of Engineering conducted a health survey on 17^{th} of November 2017 at NADAVATHI village in HOSKOTE taluk, which is 5 km away from Channasandra .

Nadavathi is a remote village in the vicinity of Channasandra which is known for its sceneric beauty and eye pleasing agricultural fields. It has a population of approximately 2000 people where the ratio of male to female is roughly equal. The aim of NSS-MVJCE unit was to render our services to the people by conducting a survey through which we understood the problems faced by the residents of nadavathi . A team of 50 NSS volunteers led by 5 NSS coordinators—reached the place at 10:30 am. We analysed the place well before starting the survey and were divided into 7 teams consisting of 3-4 volunteers. Each team headed in different directions to infer about the people's health issues.

Our volunteers visited each house and spoke to the villagers regarding their health problems and noted every important issue. Our team was successful in inquiring about 200 residents suffering from various health issues like knee pain, eye sight problems, weakness, skin diseases etc... we assured them that there will be a free medical camp held soon.
