

Workshop on Career Counselling

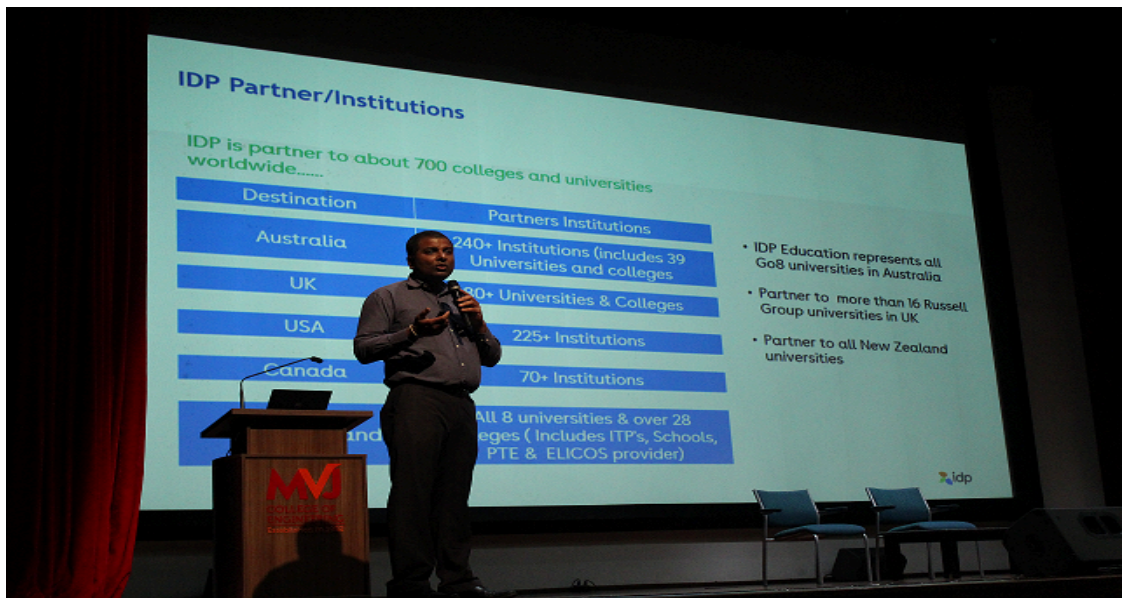
