3. To encourage, guide and handhold mentee institution in adoption of IIC policy.

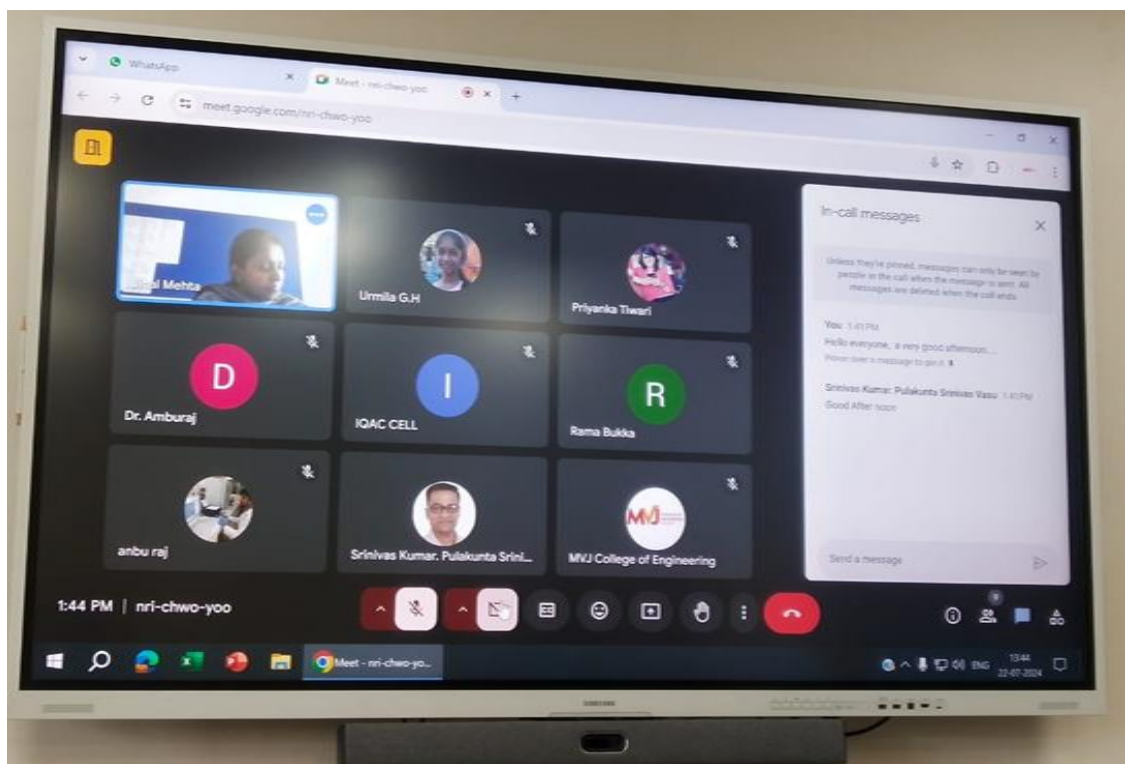
