## **About the Activity**

The club activity was centered around applying conceptual knowledge to sustainably manage e waste used in various industries. The activity also included different rounds, such as an educational quiz with a twist in the form of Bingo as well as novel idea presentation on chart sheet on sustainable management on e-waste.

## A Brief Account of the Activity

The session commenced with a welcome address by Mr. Subash and Mr. Alan, both students from the Department of Chemical Engineering. They emphasized the significance of the activity and outlined the rules and procedures for the event.

The activity began with a time-bound educational quiz combined with Bingo game, where students participated in 6 groups with 6 students each.
